

## About IPE

Institute of Public Enterprise (IPE), Hyderabad is a non-profit educational society devoted to Education, Training, Research and Consultancy for business enterprises in the public and private sector. IPE is a premier Business School and is recognized as a 'Centre of Excellence' by the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Ministry of Human Resources, Government of India, for doctoral studies. It has also been recognized by seven universities in India for guidance of PhD scholars. It has developed strong links with industry and academic institutions and is the founder member of the Association of Indian Management Schools (AIMS).

IPE strongly believes that human resource development including education is crucial for economic growth. As part of its long-term education program, the Institute runs Post Graduate Diploma in Business Management recognized by AICTE. The Course is also recognized as equivalent to MBA by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
