Linux is a Unix-like computer operating system assembled under the model of free and open source software development and distribution. Linux powers 94% of the world's supercomputers, most of the servers powering the Internet, the majority of financial trades worldwide and a billion Android devices. In short, Linux is everywhere. It appears in many different architectures, from mainframes to server to desktop to mobile and on a staggeringly wide variety of hardware. Linux based systems are increasingly being used to power mission critical server systems, network servers and desktops. With its open source heritage and rich applications, organizations have for the first time available with them open standards based platform. Linux is a "modern operating system", with features such as High Data Security, Virtual Machines, memory protection, and preemptive multitasking.

The objective of the hands-on training is to help systems engineers and administrators acquire a practical insight into the working and administration of a Linux based system.
