We are offering a mix of both online and offline teaching and give the option to the students to choose whatever format they wish is because some students have informed us that they wish to be cautious in Term 1, and prefer to study online. But some other students have conveyed to us that they are keen on having the face-to-face learning experience, as they value the learning they get from the real-time interactions and peer learning. Our approach of offering blended learning incorporating both online and offline teaching, ensures you get the best of both the formats, with students free to choose whichever format they prefer, depending on their personal preference.

For those of you who choose to study in a classroom, social distancing measures, as prescribed by GOI and Sate Govt. from time to time, will be implemented to ensure your safety and health.
